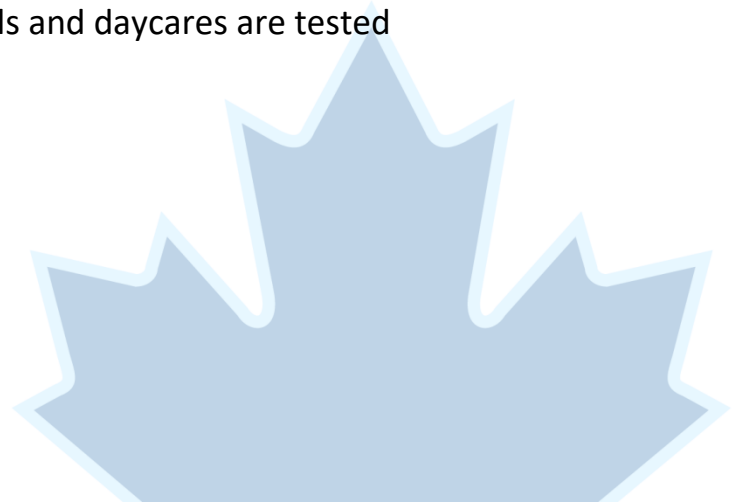

Municipalities – What can you do?

- Building Codes
 - amend to include radon control measures and mandatory testing
- Recommend policy changes to require testing in rental dwellings
- Provide grants or low interest loans to help residents with mitigation
- Host community awareness forums
 - include medical experts and C-NRPP certified radon professionals, Lung and Cancer associations
- Provide residents with information through:
 - Libraries
 - Town halls
 - Information on your website
 - Information in utility bills
 - Health Canada, Canadian Cancer Society, CARST and C-NRPP all have resources that you can use (see reverse for contact information)
- Proper Training
 - For building officials; contact C-NRPP for information
 - Testing and mitigating with C-NRPP certified professionals
- Conduct surveys to help decision makers with policy decisions
- Test all public buildings; ensure schools and daycares are tested
